
# SERPENTINE COURT BALLOT ON PROPOSALS

You will be voting for one of the below options:



## **Option A –**NO red<u>evelopment</u>

#### **Existing site plan for ballot Option A**


The 'NO' option means that there will be NO redevelopment (demolition or construction) on Serpentine Court.



The existing homes will remain and maintenance works will be carried out as per the replacement lifecycles detailed in the Council's HRA (Housing Revenue Account) Business Plan. The replacement lifecycles are assessed as requiring the following over the next 30 years:

- 381 Kitchens
- 194 Bathrooms
- 232 Window replacements UPVC double gazed
- 403 Door replacements UPVC composite front doors
- 1589 Electrical works
- 373 Boiler/heating replacements
- 371 External works, roofs, balconies, security entry and decorations
- · Lift replacement


In addition to the above maintenance, the day to day service for urgent repairs will continue, as will any Health and Safety works.



### **Option B -**PARTIAL redevelopment

#### Site plan for ballot Option B

The PARTIAL redevelopment Option B means that some existing homes will be retained, some would be demolished and new homes would be built.
